



Power On:

Press the button until you hear a beeping sound and the LED indicator light comes on.

Press the ① button until you hear a beeping sound and the LED indicator light goes off.

To Pair Bluetooth:

- 1. Press the 🛈 button until you hear a beeping sound and the LED indicator light comes on. The LED light will start flashing blue rapidly as it enters Bluetooth mode.
- 2. Make sure that the speaker is within 10 meters of your Bluetooth device.
- 3. Go to the Bluetooth settings on your device, search and select "boAt Stone 300" from the list of
- 4. Once successfully paired, the LED indicator turns solid blue.

Note:

- When powered on, the speaker automatically reconnects to the last device it was connected to. (The speaker can memorize maximum of 8 paired devices).
- The speaker will automatically shut down to save power if after 10 minutes, it has not been paired.
- Please note that play time will vary depending on the selected volume level.

Disconnect Bluetooth

Press the "+", "-" buttons simultaneously until you hear a beep and the LED Indicator light is rapidly flashing blue to disconnect the currently connected device.

Aux Mode

- 1. Press the **(1)** button until you hear a beeping sound and the LED indicator light comes on.
- 2. Insert the AUX Cable (φ3.5mm) into the Aux port on the speaker and on the external device.
- 3. The speaker will automatically turn to AUX-in mode; and the LED Indicator light will turn solid

Note: In AUX-IN mode, changing songs and hands-free communication is not available.



To Charge

- (1) Use a micro USB charging cable to charge the speakers: it is recommended that the speakers are
- fully charged before first time use.
- (2) Connect the Micro-USB Cable (included) between the DCIN port on the speaker, and a USB port on a computer or USB AC Adapter.
- (3) Charging: The red light is on and not blinking.
- (4) Fully charged: the Red light will go off.
- (5) It is recommended that the speakers are not used while they are being charged, as it is not good
- Note: When the battery charge <3%, the speaker will power off automatically.

- Do not use alcohol, benzene and other chemicals to clean the speaker.
- Do not allow the speaker within range of extremely hot or cold substances.
- Try to ensure that no physical damage comes to the speaker via falling, or coming into contact with hard surfaces or sharp edges.
- Do not dismantle the speaker in any way. If any issue arises with the speaker, please enlist the aid of a manufacturer.
- The battery must not be mishandled or replaced as when it can result in explosions or fire hazards. Therefore, please ensure that any servicing of the speaker is done through the service provider or

Troubleshooting:

- Charge the headphone and make sure it has enough battery charge.
- 2. Trouble connecting with device:
- · Please check the follows:
- The Bluetooth device supports A2DP profile
- The Speaker is within 10m from the device
- The Speaker is in pairing mode, the LED indicator blinking blue and blue

- Make sure the music volume is at audible level on both your device and speaker.
- Make sure your device is successfully paired with the headphone, the LED indicator turn solid blue.
